FOLSOM EUROPE: Inspiré de la *Folsom Street Fair* de San Francisco, le plus gros festival de rue Cuir / Fetish d'Europe se déroule à Berlin au début du mois de septembre depuis 2007.

KETAMINE: Anesthésique d'action rapide non barbiturique aux effets hallucinogènes dissociatifs.

MDMA: 3,4-Methylenedioxyamphétamine : principe actif de l'Ecstasy, amphétamine aux effets empathogènes et entactogènes.

KAMAGRA: Générique du Viagra (Sildénafil), en vente sur internet.

POPPERS vs. VIAGRA: Les effets vasodilatateurs cumulés du poppers (nitrite d'amyle) et des médicaments utilisés pour la dysfonction érectile comme le Kamagra peuvent entraîner des accidents cardiovasculaires.
